FAITH REMINDERS

- 1) God loves us and wants the best for us. (1 John 4:8) (Ephesians 2:4) (3 John 1:2) We have to know that God wants our body healed, our mind restored and our finances in order. It is a lie of Christian religion that has assigned evil to God. Sick bodies, sick minds and poverty are all forms of stealing and God is not a thief. (John 10:10) (Romans 13:10)
- 2) God's love is activated into our life by grace through faith. (Ephesians 2:8) (Romans 5:2) No one deserves the blessing of God. (Romans 3:23, 24) Trying to earn God's favor only leads to disappointment. (Galatians 3:10) (James 2:10) Our faith does not move God. Our faith appropriates what God has already provided by grace. (Ephesians 1:3) (2 Peter 1:3) (1 John 4:16) (Galatians 5:6)
- 3) God has given every born again believer the measure of faith. (Romans 12:3) Every born again believer has the faith of Christ. (Galatians 2:20 KJV) The devil has deceived us into thinking our faith is not big enough. The truth is we have mountain moving size faith and we simply have to use it. (Matthew 17:20) (Luke 17:5, 6) Faith is not measured by how much we have but by how much we use. (Romans 4:19)
- 4) We don't have a faith problem we have an unbelief problem. We don't need more faith, we need less unbelief. (Mark 6:6) (Mark 9:24) (Romans 4:20) If we believe faith reminders #1, #2 & #3 then our biggest obstacle to overcome will be natural unbelief. (Hebrews 11:1) (2 Corinthians 4:18) We have to become spiritually minded. (Romans 8:5) The truth of God's Word has to be believed even when natural circumstances say otherwise. (Romans 3:4) The word of God must be more prominent in our lives than our 5 physical senses. (John 12:38) This will only occur though studying the Word, praying in faith and fellowshipping with like minded saints. (2 Timothy 2:15) (2 Corinthians 10:5) (1 Corinthians 15:33) (Philippians 4:8) We must turn off the noise of the world and get quiet before God. (Psalm 46:10) We need to pray for a Revelation of God's love. (Ephesians 3:19) The Lord is good, his mercy is everlasting and his truth endures to all generations. (Psalm 100:5)
- 5) God loves us the same as he did the day we received Jesus. (John 17:23) Our behavior (good or bad) hasn't changed his opinion of us at all. (Malachi 3:6) Jesus' blood cleanses us from all sins past, present and future. (Hebrews 9:23) Let's dare to believe and receive and not doubt and do without. (Mark 11:22,23,24)
